Vice Chairman Gordon Burgess called the regularly scheduled quarterly meeting of the Zachary Taylor Parkway Association Board of Directors to order at the Southern Forest Heritage Museum in Rapides Parish.

Mr. Louis Hebert called the roll with those in attendance shown above. A quorum was declared. In addition to guest previously introduced Mr. Hebert Mr. Dukes from Pointe Coupee parish.

Mr. A. P. Guillory made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 12, 2008 as presented. With a second and unanimous vote the motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was presented by Treasurer Billy D'Aquilla showing an ending balance of \$76,379.84. The report was duly accepted with a motion, second and unanimous vote.

Mr. Burgess asked for the appointment of two committees.

Dr. James Nelson was introduced as the guest speaker by Mr. Burgess. A retired physician and an avid bicyclist, he shared information about biking in the State of Louisiana. He implored the group to consider creating a multi use path approximately 12' in width along the Zachary Taylor Parkway for

biking, walking, skating or horseback riding. Biking and the benefits from exercise create a healthier life style. Many nationally recognized groups come to bike in our area of the state.

Dr. Nelson was thanked for his presentation and the attendees were reminded that the Zachary Taylor Parkway has been very conscious of this need. In addition, regulations require that all modes of transportation be considered.

Southern Forest Heritage Museum Executive Director and Zachary Taylor Parkway Association Member Bob Carroll extended an invitation to take a tour of the museum with lunch being served immediately afterwards.

Mr. Burgess extended thanks to the museum for our meeting location and Rapides Parish for hosting our June meeting.
